

Decatur County Council Meeting

Tuesday April 21, 2015 Room 106

Present: Ernie Gauck, Geneva Hunt, Larry Meyers, Bill Metz, Kenny Owens, Danny Peters and Kenny Hooten.

President Gauck called the meeting to order.

Sandy Biddinger led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The March 24th meeting minutes were reviewed- Mr Hooten moved to approve the minutes and Mr Peters seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mr Gauck read the request for additional monies submitted by Matt Hoeing of the **Decatur County Probation Office** for \$3,502 for the lease for a copier. The requests for transfer of monies within budgets were reviewed. Mr Metz moved to approve the request for additional monies and the transfer of monies; Mr Owens seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mr Owens moved to transfer \$34,295 in Fund 4902- **Airport Improvement Fund** to the **County General Fund**. Mr Metz seconded the motion. Motion carried. This money is the County's share of reimbursement monies for an environmental study done when Decatur County was still a part of the **Airport Commission**. Once Decatur County withdrew/dissolved the **Decatur County – Greensburg Airport Commission**, Greensburg's half of the Airport Improvement fund was issued to them as directed by the **State Board of Accounts**.

Mr Gauck requested a 'better display' of Decatur County employees' salaries (100 R) as required by statute. Copies of the 100 R will be sent to the public library as well as posting on our county website.

Mr Peters told Council members the **E911 Steering Committee** is meeting Wednesday, April 22nd and that committee wants to increase the **E911 Board** from seven members to ten members. Mr Gauck stated any changes have to come before the County Council since **E911** answers to the County Council.

The next Council meeting will be at 9:00 a.m. on May 19, 2015.

With nothing else to come before the Council, Mr Hooten moved to adjourn and Mr Peters seconded. Meeting adjourned.
