

Decatur County Community Corrections Advisory Board
Meeting Minutes

Meeting was called to order by Judge Timothy Day at 12:05pm.

A motion to approve the minutes was made by Denise Burton and seconded by Ashley Hungate. Motion was carried with unanimous approval.

Abby Harry gave report for Court Services.

Project Income Balance: \$132,632.37

CTP Balance: \$27,100.00

Abby reported that there are currently 17 clients being monitored through community corrections. The drop in numbers was discussed, but with the rise in pretrial assessments and the implementation of the drug screen hotline the workload as remained the same for Community Corrections. Abby also advised that numbers were down across the board and thanked the prosecutor's office for giving teeth to the violations that were filed as there were fewer violations committed while on home detention and probation.

There was no old business to report. Quarterly meetings for 2026 would be March 6, June 5, September 11, and December 4. All would take place in the EMA Conference Room

Matt Hoeing gave an update on the previous transportation request. After speaking with the Ford Dealership, a 2026 Ford Maverick Gas would be \$30,800 while a Hybrid would be \$31,800. The trade in value of the current vehicle (van) would be \$15,000 and Matt, having spoken to the auditor, stated that there would be an additional \$10,000 through ARPA. This leaves a balance of approximately \$7500 that could be paid out of project income with the approval of the board. A motion to allow the aforementioned trade with the permitted use of up to \$7,500.00 of project income was made by Nathan Harter IV and seconded by Dr. Jarrod Burns. This motion carried unanimously.

Judge Day then gave a brief update on open appointments for the board:

Crime Victim – appointment by commissioners


Casa Worker – Judge Day
