INSTRUCTIONS FOR VACATING ALLEYS & STREETS

- 1. To vacate an alley, the property owner must come into the County Auditor's office to obtain the petition.
- 2. While the property owner is in the office, make a copy of the area from the plat map and from Beacon. Make sure the street or alley to be vacated is highlighted. Review the adjoining property owner's names.
- 3. The property owner will take the petition to all adjoining property owners and obtain a signature. After the signatures are collected, return the petition to the Auditor's office.
- 4. The property owner will mail a certified "notice of hearing" prepared by the Auditor's office to all adjoining property owners. The property owner will also have the "notice of hearing" legally advertised in <u>two local newspapers</u>. The property owner is also required to post the "notice of hearing" in <u>two different public places</u>.
- 5. The Auditor's office will prepare the ordinance and certificate of ordinance for the Commissioners to sign after the hearing. The Auditor will record the Ordinance.
