ARTICLE 19

KENNELS

SECTION 1910 – Definition

Kennel shall be defined as any parcel of real estate on which household domestic animals are maintained, boarded, trained, bred, raised, groomed, or cared for in exchange for pay, barter, commission, or remuneration of any kind.

SECTION 1920 – Permitted Districts

Kennels are permitted as a Permanent Special Exception in the A-1 and A-2 zoning districts when approved by the Board of Zoning Appeals and as a Permitted Use in the B-2 zoning district when approved by the Decatur County Board of Zoning Appeals.

SECTION 1930 – Location

Kennels shall be located One Hundred Fifty (150) feet or more from adjoining property lines.

SECTION 1940 – State Licensing and Regulation

All kennels shall comply with State licensing requirements and shall follow all State agency regulations that apply.
