DUTIES:

Supervise daily activities for special needs campers.

Identifies and responds to specific needs of the individual campers.

Follows all safety procedures and rules set forth by the Camp Director.

Administers first aid when needed.

Performs related duties as assigned.

JOB REQUIREMENTS:

Must be at least 16 years of age.

Ability to meet all hiring requirements including passage of a drug screening, background check and medical exam.

Thorough knowledge of Department programs and services, with strong organizational, communications, problem-solving skills as well as passion for and commitment to engaging with special needs children.

PERSONAL WORK RELATIONSHIPS:

Incumbent maintains frequent contact with co-workers, children, parents and guardians, for the purpose of exchanging information, instructing, mentoring, and supervising.

Incumbent reports directly to the Camp Director.

PHYSICAL EFFORT AND WORK ENVIRONMENT:

Incumbent performs most of duties outdoors including sitting/walking at will, sitting/standing/walking for long periods, lifting/carrying/pushing/pulling objects weighing over 50 pounds, bending, reaching, crouching/kneeling, handling/grasping objects, close/far vision, color and depth perception, hearing sounds/communication, and speaking clearly. When outside, incumbent walks on uneven terrain, works in wet/icy surroundings and extreme temperatures, and in noisy environments.
